





# Style overview



#### Flexible roof

A modern angular skillion roof, bold gable or flat roof style adds clean modernist lines to the facade and immediately evoke a contemporary Kiwi and coastal architectural style.

#### Vertical cladding

The fresh facade typically features earthy, dark lightweight vertical cladding such as weatherboards. The elongated vertical facade is dominating this modern evolution of coastal living.

#### Earthy colour palette

In New Zealand the coastal homes merge with their surrounds, and are sympathetic rather than standing out. Darker and more earthy tones are favoured creating a seamless transition between the house and the surrounding landscape.

#### Wellbeing

The pared back, effortless coastal design epitomises laid-back luxury ideal for entertainment and relaxation. Indoor/outdoor flow and coastal views ensure an uninterrupted connection to nature and one another.

#### Interiors

Inside, the Modern Bach style often includes an open-plan living area, with a focus on natural light and a connection to the outdoors. The use of neutral colours, such as white, gray, and beige, helps to create a relaxed and calming atmosphere, complementing the more rustic and neutral expression of these homes.





#### Doors

The simple profile of a shaker-style door perfectly evokes beachside luxury. Use matching or complimentary doors inside the home for a consistent look and feel.



#### Accents

Use of screening provides a design contrast and are a great way to provide privacy and protection from the coastal elements.







Combining dramatically high ceilings with flexible floor plans, the Barn offers rural charm in urban surroundings. As the style has evolved, the Barn has become illustrative of simple, relaxed design with an emphasis on function and family.

# Style overview



#### Flexible roof

While the peaked roof is symbolic of the heritage of this design, modern interpretations play with the roof lines to create asymmetry and the use of bold colours to stand out from the crowd.

#### Colour blocked

The simplicity of shape and cladding dominant materiality of the barn calling out for bold colour blocking. Think terracotta's, reds and even pastels to stand out from the crowd in urban and regional settings.

#### Deep and/or absence of eaves

There should also be either a complete absence of eaves or oversized eaves which provides a striking silhouette and shade to entrances and alfresco areas.

#### Large rectangular windows

Floor to ceiling windows accentuate the length of the house. Combine with outdoor decks and large sliding doors to connect with nature.

#### Interiors

The key design flexibility qualities of the Barn style include open floor plans, multipurpose living spaces indoor/outdoor integration and energy efficiency upgrades.







# Style overview



#### Hidden roof line

Parapet walls hide the roof line and make it appear flat. The capping or guttering can blend with the cladding or be used to create a dark outline to accentuate the shape against the sky.

#### Contrasting exterior


Horizontal or vertical cladding or even panel layouts with mixed materials distinguish each box shape.

#### Flexibility

In Box Modern design, the simple box shape takes on new meaning. New Zealand design has given the box character through mixing materials, playing with colour and height. It has maintained its popularity due to its versatility. Low boxes stay cool and are more cost-effective, while stacked boxes create modular flexibility for multi-generational living.




Box Modern

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#### Doors





#### Feature roof line





#### Doors

A contrasting coloured front door, with a feature handle is an eye-catching addition to the home's entrance.

#### Accents

Minimalist sconce lights in organic shapes to contrast the strong angles of the dominant roofline, such as a tubular design that throws light up and down. Bold house numbers in a thin, straight font on the facade and letterbox ties the look together.



#### Landscaping

Mid-century modern landscaping is minimal, reflecting the "form follows function" design approach. Hardwearing, low maintenance plants are ideal, such as ornamental grasses and native shrubbery. 

#### Windows

Steel window frames play a key role in creating texture and complement the natural surroundings.



#### Accents







# Style overview



#### Minimalist architecture

Simple structures with clean, sleek lines. Roofs can be flat, gabled, hipped or square pyramidal with deep overhangs to protect windows from rain.

#### Building efficiencies

Japandi design emphasises efficient building techniques by incorporating streamlined energy systems, simplified construction methods, water-efficient features and durable, sustainable materials.

#### Complementary colours

A collection of earthy, neutral colours. The richer colours of Japanese design help to keep the stark, crisp palettes of Scandinavian homes from feeling clinical or cold.

#### Wellbeing

Japandi homes are designed with a view to wellbeing, with neutral colours, simple layouts and indoor-outdoor connection, providing a sense of tranquillity. Design features such as as shoji (moveable screens), fusuma (sliding doors) a tokonoma (recess or alcove), genken (entryway), engawa (covered outdoor corridor), and courtyards, among other elements to blur inside and outside.

#### Interiors

Interior style is minimal without being cold, utilising natural materials, neutral colours and simple layouts with an emphasis on indoor-outdoor connectivity.

## Style overview





### Flexible roof

The roof style can either match or contrast the existing structure with closest matching flashings, gutters and barges. Flat roofs are often adopted in the back with minimal millwork retained on the roof edges to retain heritage characteristics.

### Modern extension

The style allows for revelation of the existing building and celebrates the original materials and the history of alterations. The modern extension should complement the character of the home whilst blending into modernity.

### Wellbeing

Small, terraced houses often have a sheltered area or courtyard at the back for modern living bring the outside in, while larger homes can feature multiple verandahs or patios for a deeper connection to nature.





### Doors

Doors on the home's extension should be simple and sleek in design, allowing the heritage features of the original structure to shine. Screening on upper storey extensions let light in while providing privacy from close neighbours.



### Accents




### Hardscaping
